NOTICE

Dear Tourist,

The historical town of Peschiera del Garda is pleased and honoured to have you as its guest and offers you a warm welcome. The local council always wants to provide a pleasant and relaxing atmosphere and hopes that you will find the services it offers agreeable to your stay.

We would be grateful, however, if you would spare a few moments of your valuable time to read this leaflet carefully. In it we explain a few little local rules and regulations, to which we ask you to adhere.

If you have brought your dog with you, please note that in public areas you are required to have with you the means to remove dog litter (scoop, gloves, plastic bag) and to show these, if so requested, to police officers. Dog owners are furthermore required to collect up any dog litter and place it in the closed plastic bag in the appropriate litter bin. Contravention of these rules is subject to a fine of between € 25.82 and € 516.46.

We further remind you that it is compulsory to keep your dog on a leash on the street and in public places, also in shops, on public transport and in places where there are large numbers of people (fairs, markets, festive events, etc.). Offenders are liable to a fine of between € 258.00 and € 1.291.00.

Each year, from the month of May and until September, dogs are not allowed on the beaches and in bathing areas. A fine of between € 25.00 and € 154.00 can be imposed.

If you hope to benefit from using a bike during your holiday, either in the streets of the town or to admire the splendid views which Lake Garda affords you, do not forget the existence of a few small but important rules for your own safety and that of other road users.

We would especially like to advise you that in pedestrian areas, in the old town centre and along the lakeside promenades, bikes must be parked in the appropriate cycle racks or pushed by hand; you must give consideration to people on pavements and not go against the flow of pedestrians. Local fines can be expected for non-compliance.

With regard to dress, the wearing of bathing costumes or being bare-chested is not allowed other than in campsites and on the beaches. Swimming, however, is not allowed other than on the beaches and is particularly forbidden along the canals that surround the walls of Peschiera del Garda. Again, local fines are in force for contravention.

In all public areas but with special reference to the beaches,

- it is forbidden to shout, sing loudly or use musical instruments or radios producing sounds, noise or the spoken word at a level which annoys or disturbs the relaxation of other people;
- it is forbidden to play ball or other games which could endanger the safety of or disturb the peace of the public, except in places intended for this purpose;
- it is forbidden to light fires and barbecues in public areas.

Finally, you are reminded that heavy fines, equal to € 3.333.33, are liable for anyone caught transacting a purchase or accepting goods which, for their quality, quantity, price and conditions of sale suggest infringement or counterfeit goods. For this reason we ask you not to purchase goods other than in shops.
